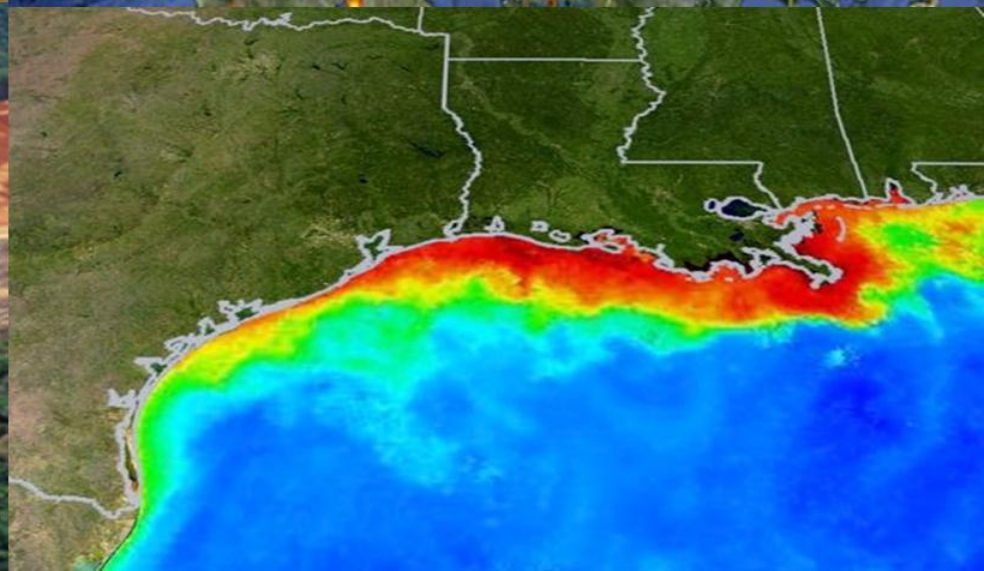

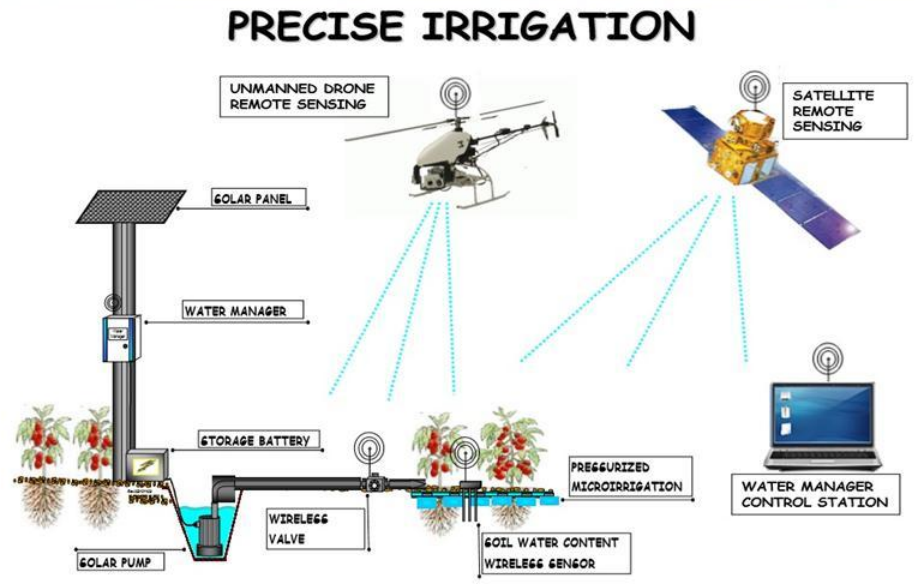


INTEGRATED ENVIRONMENTAL - PROTECTION SOIL ORGANIC MATTER

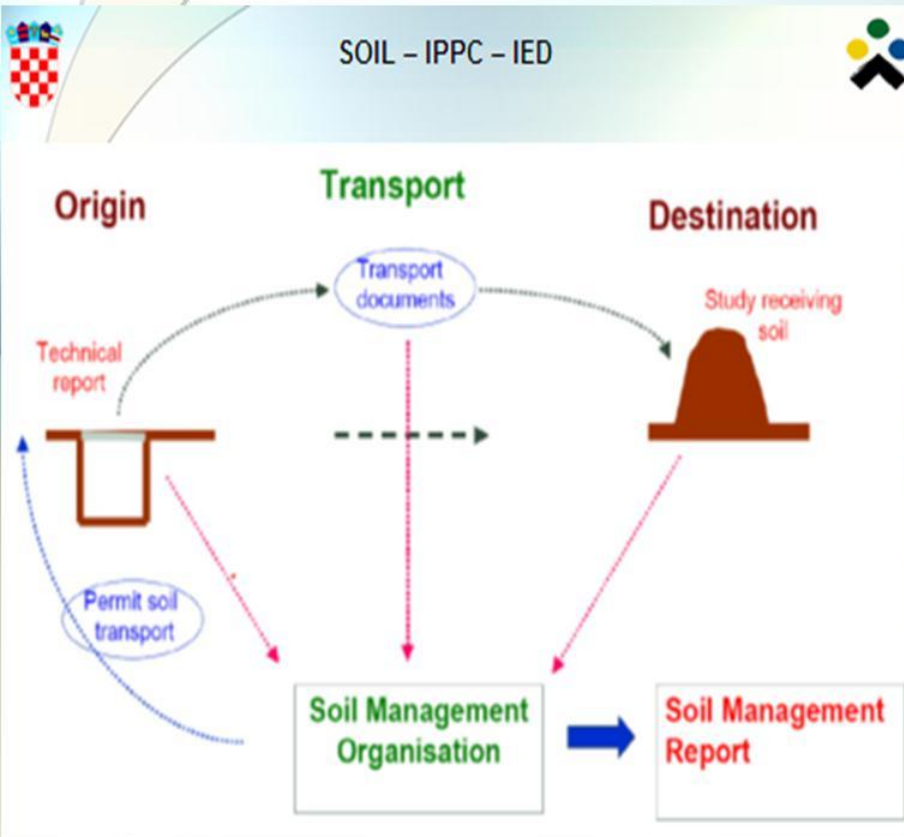
